C.A.P.E. is a partnership program, hosted by the South African National Biodiversity Institute (SANBI) that seeks to conserve and restore the biodiversity of the Cape Floristic Region and adjacent marine environment, while delivering significant benefits to the people of the region. Component 6 of the C.A.P.E. Programme deals with Watershed Management and consists of three sub-components. This project constitutes sub-component 6.2.1, i.e. the C.A.P.E. Invasive Alien Species (IAS) Programme.

The C.A.P.E. IAS strategy was developed in consultation with C.A.P.E. partners between 2007 and 2008. The vision of the C.A.P.E. IAS Strategy is that: *“By 2020, the negative impacts of Invasive Alien Species on the Greater Cape Floristic Region’s economic, ecological and social assets are already significantly reduced, no further indigenous species have been allowed to be driven to extinction by IAS, and sustainable programmes are in place to see this impact reduction continue in the future”*. The strategy aims to provide a framework for collaboration between role-players and optimal resource allocation. It contains a set of principles, goals and objectives, strategic actions and desired outcomes.
