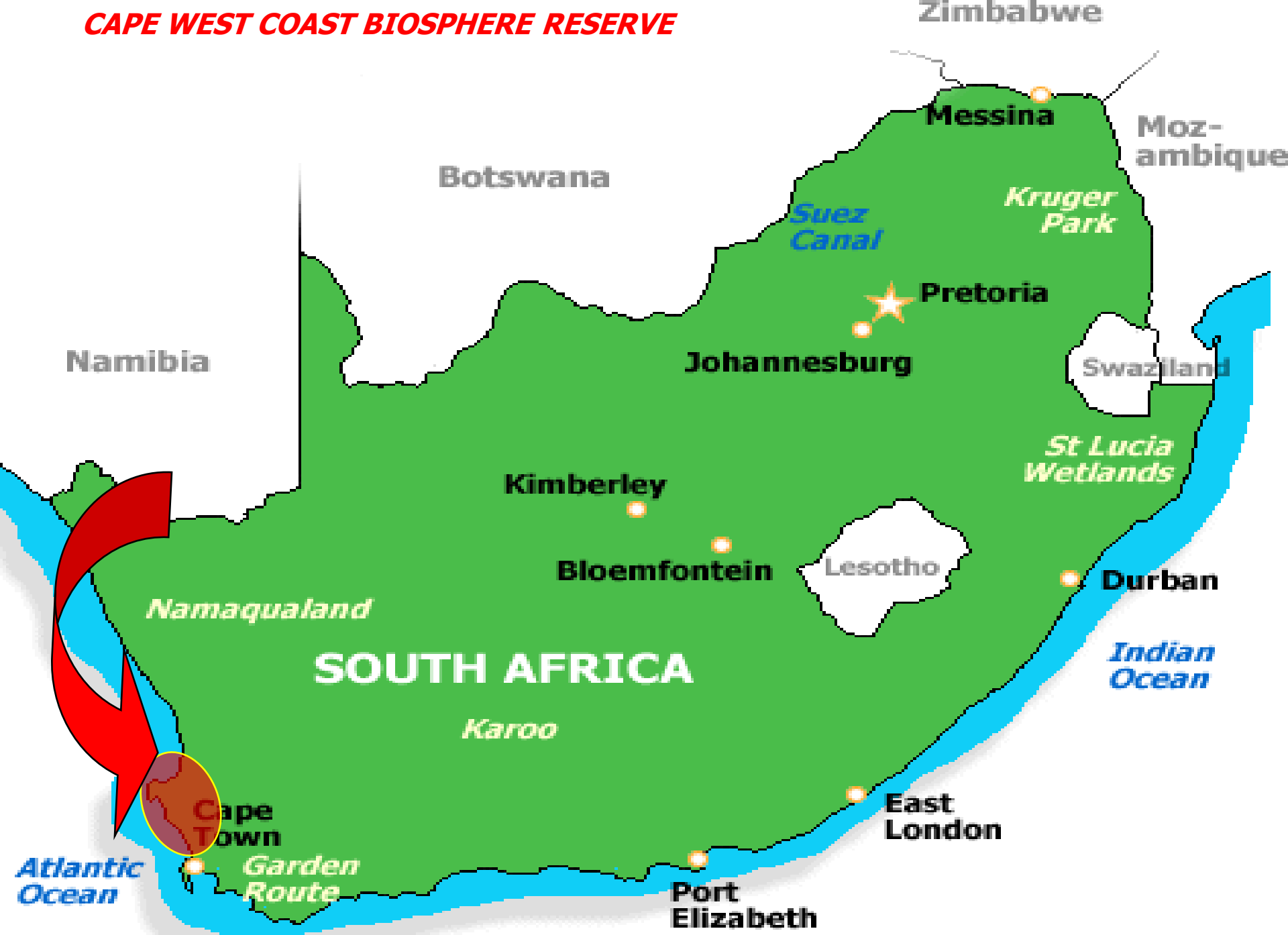

CAPE WEST COAST BIOSPHERE RESERVE





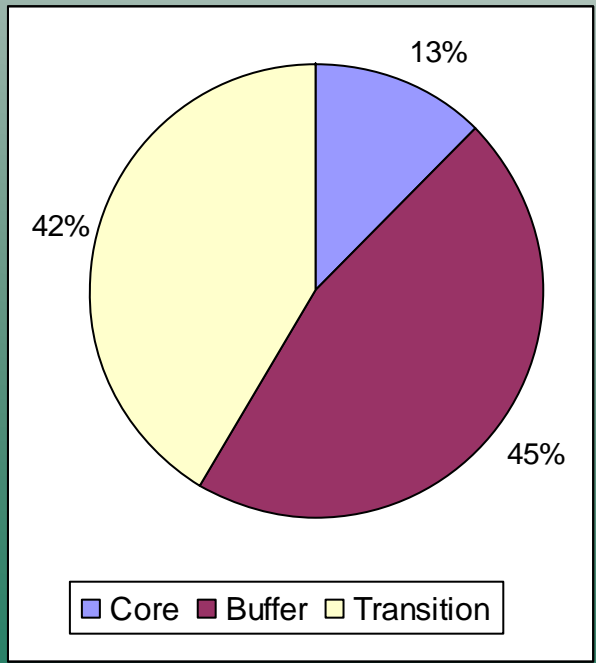
Core Area: 47,490 Ha
